Although it was an unseasonably hot day, the celebration of our Parish Festival went very well on September 24. Enough children braved the heat to have a good time

in the afternoon, and there was enough shade and water to keep everyone safe. The attendance at Mass was better than usual. And the dinner and celebration afterward was fantastic. I would like to thank Sarah Altstaetter and her team for their leadership. This was the first year she was leading the effort, and she did a great job. Tim Gillen once again put together a great dinner. Thanks to all who made this possible. If I started to mention names, I'm sure I would leave someone out. But all of you deserve great gratitude for your efforts.

This weekend we begin our annual Perpetuate the Gift Campaign for the Priests' Retirement Fund for our diocesan priests. The poster for this year's campaign is a photo taken from the Jubilee celebration for our priests this past year. Most (5) of those priests, including our previous pastor Fr. Ed Schleter, celebrated their 50th anniversary of ordination. One celebrated his 40th anniversary; though he is not in full senior status, Fr. Dave Tscherne is currently temporary administrator at Bryan and Montpelier as their pastor undergoes chemotherapy. One of the priests, Fr. Greg Peatee, celebrated his 25th anniversary and is still active. This poster is a capsule of the service of our priests and highlights our need to support our senior priests. Once they attain senior status, they normally have to provide for their own room and board, so their expenses increase. This retirement fund helps them in those expenses and also provides a supplement for their Medicare plan. So it is crucial for priests like Fr. Bob Holden, who is now in expensive nursing home care.

This becomes important to me as I am now in the 40th year of my priesthood. I support this fund financially myself, trusting it will be there for me in the not-too-distant future. Remember that all contributions received by December 31 of this year will count toward our parish subsidy of the Retirement Fund. Please support those priests who have given so much to the local Church of Toledo.

Se celebró su 40 aniversario; aunque él no en el estado mayor completo, el P. Dave Tscherne es actualmente administrador temporal en Bryan y Montpelier como su pastor se somete a quimioterapia. Uno de los sacerdotes, el P. Greg Peatee, celebró su 25 aniversario y sigue activo. Este cartel es una cápsula del servicio de nuestros sacerdotes y destaca nuestra necesidad de apoyar a nuestros sacerdotes mayores. Una vez que alcancen el estatus de senior, normalmente tienen que proveer para su propia habitación y comida, por lo que sus gastos aumentan. Este fondo de retiro les ayuda en esos gastos y también proporciona un suplemento para su plan de Medicare. Así que es crucial para los sacerdotes como el P. Bob Holden, que ahora está en la atención de enfermería muy caro.

Esto es importante para mí, como ahora estoy en el año 40 de mi sacerdocio. Apoyo financieramente este fondo, confiando en que estará allí para mí en un futuro no muy lejano. Recuerde que todas las contribuciones recibidas hasta el 31 de Diciembre de este año contarán para nuestro subsidio parroquial del Fondo de Retiro.
