When my new assignment to Our Lady of Lourdes was announced, the bishop

also announced that the new pastor here will be Fr. Stan Tabor. Fr. Stan (Stanislaw) has been in our diocese since last Fall, serving as Administrator at St. Michael in Gibsonburg and St. Mary in Millersville. He sent me some information about him. He was born in Poland in 1958 and was ordained in 1984 for the Diocese of Sosnowiec, in which he is still incardinated. He moved, with his bishop's permission, to the United States in 2006 (originally for a year) to broaden his pastoral experience. He has served in Illinois and Indiana until recently.

Fr. Stan tells me he likes speaking English but "...in English I cannot say what I want." He is also able to say Mass in Spanish, which was a factor in coming here where we have a weekly Spanish Mass. In his free time, he plays the organ, piano, guitar and the accordion. He wants to serve God through the people, parishes and places to which he is sent. We welcome Fr. Stan to our parish and our community. His varied experience should enrich all of us.

This coming week, all donors in the previous several years to the Annual Catholic Appeal who have not yet responded will receive a reminder letter from the diocese. If you haven't responded to the pledge request, please do so as soon as possible. We still have envelopes at the Church entrances in case you do not have the envelope that was mailed to you at the beginning of the campaign. 
Scholarships for St. Caspar Seniors

Su experiencia variada nos va a enriquecer a todos.
