A Look In The Past 175 Years In Our Parish

Fr. Paul Mueller became pastor in 1968. He completed the finishing touches to the church (e.g. outdoor landscaping, matching sanctuary furniture and adornments). He noted that the Parish had doubled in the past 10 years, due largely to job opportunities in Wauseon. The parish roster in 1968 consisted of 320 families and 1,382 souls.




