Are You Formally Registered in the Parish?

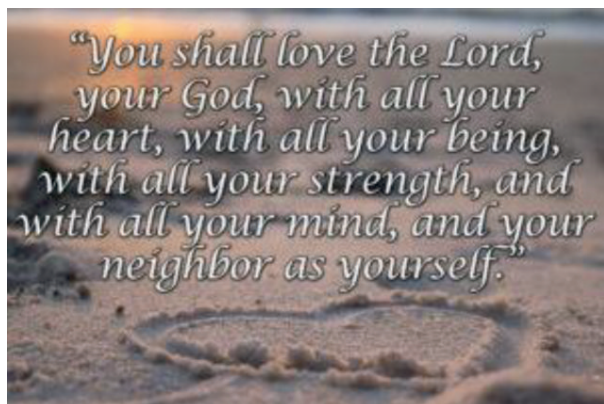

What Was Jesus' Last Name?

During Jesus' time, Jewish people had only a first name. They didn't have last names.

A person would be distinguished from others with the same name by identifying the town they lived in. So, "Jesus" became "Jesus of Nazareth."

If several men in Nazareth were named Jesus, they were further distinguished by identifying their father. Thus, Jesus would be called "Jesus, son of Joseph." (In Aramaic, "son of" is "bar". So, "Jesus Bar-joseph".)



A Look In The Past 175 Years In Our Parish

The Spanish Americans were given added attention during Fr. Paul Mueller's 1968-1973 pastorate. Following the work of the two previous pastors, summer schools were held for the Spanish—sometimes providing a Spanish priest for the area or classes led by local seminarians and several Franciscan nuns. The Cursillo movement brought spiritual growth to the parish.

"Call Me First!"



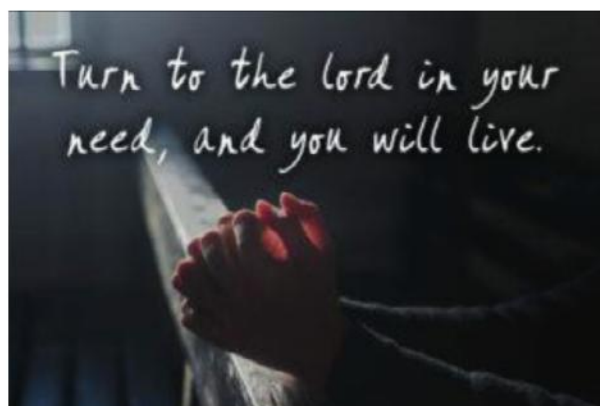


Is Your Garden Growing Crazy?

“Oh,” said the attendant, “he was courting a girl named Lulu and she turned him down.”

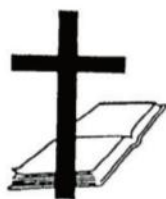
