Church Beautification Committee Update

Dear St. Caspar Family,

Allow me to update you about the church beautification process. I, along with Steve Sekula, had a meeting with Bishop Thomas on August 20, 2025. Our agenda with Bishop Thomas was to review the progress being made with the church beautification process. Bishop Thomas was excited to see the revised plans and improvements that were made by the committee. He was especially happy to hear that a statue of St. Caspar, our patron, would be included in the beautification plans. He encouraged a special enshrinement in the back of the worship space for the statue. He was also happy to hear that St. Caspar Parish family would be ready to make an official request in writing for his permission to proceed with the plans. He encouraged me and the committee to continue persevering in the great work being done. He also encouraged me to gather all interested parishioners for a general meeting to share the beautification plans and ask for the support needed to move forward.

The Beautification Committee met on September 3, 2025 to discuss the meeting with the bishop and plan our next steps. One small thing we decided was regarding the proposed art-glass Stations of the Cross. Unfortunately, the proposed art-glass Stations of the Cross we found will not work in our worship space. The Stations is too dark and the light in the building (both natural and electric lights) reflects on the glass too much making the image almost impossible to see. As they say, the station looked better on paper than the actual station. We will be continuing to study our options to enhance the Stations of the Cross. The committee also will be contacting Window Creations of Ottoville, Ohio to tell them the results of our testing the art-glass station. We also will ask Window Creations to finalize the other glass designs based on the latest recommendations from Bishop Thomas. He made three recommendations that the committee agreed were good.

We will be holding an open meeting for the interested parishioners to hear of the work of the committee and review the proposed design. I call it a "Show & Tell Meeting". The committee decided to have two meeting options mostly for your convenience. I will be presenting the same information at both meetings. You can attend either

one that fits your schedule. One meeting will be Sunday, October 19, 2025 at 2:30-4:00 p.m. The other meeting will be Tuesday, October 21, 2025 at 7:00-8:30 p.m. Both will be in the Pope John XXIII Room. Mark your calendars. As we get closer, I will give us reminders.

Thank you for your support of this beautification project which is a parish priority of our Living Christ Capital Campaign. Fr. Todd

Parishioners are asked to take a bottle home and fill it with loose change. The bottles will



In 1982 St. Caspar Parish included 540 households.

The need for more classroom space was met in 1984 with a generous bequest from parishioner Leo Miller. The space under the church proper was excavated, and seven more classrooms and a set of bathrooms were added. The pastor, Fr. Frederick "Fritz" Hug, invited Bishop James Hoffman to dedicate the new basement classroom expansion. The expansion cost \$96,400.

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

On this date in 335 two churches and a shrine erected by Constantine over the empty grave of Jesus and over the place of the crucifixion were dedicated. After these were destroyed by the Persians in 614, the Church of the Holy Sepulcher, which still stands, was erected by the Crusaders in 1149. Today also commemorates the event that led to the building of the churches dedicated in 335: the discovery of the "true cross" by St. Helena, Constantine's mother, in 326.

According to one legend, St. Helena traveled to Jerusalem on pilgrimage, in search of the true cross. Workers she hired dug through a pagan temple that had been erected on the site of the Crucifixion by Hadrian and found three crosses. A dying woman was brought in, and touched by each cross in succession, the last of which healed her. Helena ordered that this cross be divided in three parts, one to be kept in Jerusalem and the other two to be sent to Constantinople and Rome. The pieces in Jerusalem and Constantinople were ultimately lost. Slivers were taken from the portion that went to Rome until eventually it was scattered around the world.

Of course, the significance of the true cross lies not in the wood itself but in the burden that it bore. As a faithful Christian, what crosses do you accept in your life today?
