
Prayer for Unity of Christians


Women's Health Resource in Wauseon is need of items for their clinic. These are the items:

A Look In The Past 175 Years In Our Parish

For a number of years, lack of space had been a real issue for religious education classes and parish gatherings. (Classes were even held at the rectory and two parishioners' homes. Over 25 parish organizations needed meeting and social space, too.) A Vision Committee of 40 parishioners and Building Committee of 17 members met regularly over a few years. In July 2000 Fr. Bob Holden announced a Catholic fundraiser from Perrysburg had been hired to raise funds for a building expansion project. The initial goal was \$1.4 million. (The last major building project parishioners funded was the parish rectory built in 1971.)


Mark Your Calendar for a High-Energy Concert
