A Look In The Past 175 Years In Our Parish

For a number of years, lack of space had been a real issue for religious education classes and parish gatherings. (Classes were even held at the rectory and two parishioners' homes. Over 25 parish organizations needed meeting and social space, too.)

A Vision Committee of 40 parishioners and Building Committee of 17 members met regularly over a few years. In July 2000 Fr. Bob Holden announced a Catholic fundraiser from Perrysburg had been hired to raise funds for a building expansion project. The initial goal was \$1.4 million. (The last major building project parishioners funded was the parish rectory built in 1971.)

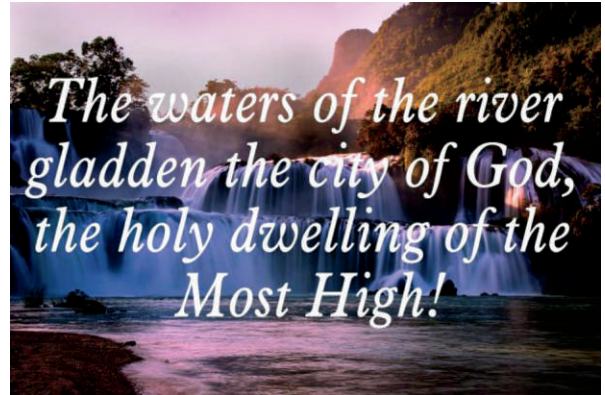
Mark Your Calendar for a High-Energy Concert

Hail Mary Pass

In football, a *Hail Mary pass* or *Hail Mary play* refers to a long forward pass, especially as a last-second attempt to score at the end of a game, where a completion has little chance of success.

The phrase was made famous by Dallas Cowboys quarterback Roger Staubach. Staubach, a Catholic, used the term to describe his game-winning 50-yard touchdown pass in a National Football League playoff game against the Minnesota Vikings on December 28, 1975. The Cowboys won the game 17-14.

Afterwards, Staubach described the play to a reporter, saying, "I closed my eyes and said a *Hail Mary*."
