



Support Our Seminarians



Catholic Fasting and Abstinence Rules

Recognizing that religious fasting is a way for us to express our need for conversion from sin and selfishness, the Roman Catholic Church prescribes the following kinds of fasts during the season of Lent: Ash Wednesday & Good Friday


Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence, which means:

- No meat (age 14 and older)
- One full meal and two smaller meals (snacks) that together do not equal the size of a full meal (ages 18 to 59)

Fridays During Lent

On all Fridays during Lent, Roman Catholics abstain from eating meat.



All services are free of charge and include: free pregnancy tests, ultrasounds and STD/STI tests; free baby items; post-abortion support; pregnancy counseling; and a baby store. CPC Women's Health Resource does not offer or refer for pregnancy terminations or birth control.
