


## Lent "Word Among Us" and Black Little Books Have Arrived!

## Ash Wednesday

We come forward this Wednesday, the first day of Lent, and are marked on the forehead with ashes in the form of the cross.

The ashes are made from palm leaves left over from Palm Sunday of the year before and are blessed at the Ash Wednesday Mass. (Wearing sackcloth and sprinkling the head with ashes were ancient signs of repentance.)

The custom of marking the head with ashes is said to have originated during the papacy of Gregory the Great (590-604). At first only public penitents received the ashes, but gradually the ashes were given to the whole congregation.

Ash Wednesday reminds us of our impending deaths. Through Christ, however, we are given eternal life. The promise of Easter gives us new hope.

## St. Vincent de Paul Food Pantry


St. Vincent de Paul Food Pantry is running low on food and they need your help. Here are the food items they need:


