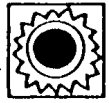

The CPC Women's Health Resource is a Christian social service agency that exists to share the Gospel of Christ, provide free assistance for unplanned pregnancies, help to heal and restore those experiencing post abortion trauma, test for sexually transmitted diseases, and advocate sexual abstinence until marriage through education.

All services are free of charge and include: free pregnancy tests, ultrasounds and STD/STI tests; free baby items; post-abortion support; pregnancy counseling; and a baby store.

- ❖ Thank you to everyone who supported the K. of C. Christmas for Kids. Your support helped over 20 area families who were those with an extreme hardship (death or illness in the family, house fire, etc.), it also will help provide assistance throughout 2025 for those in need.  
The Knights help to fund pantries, care closets and backpack buddies in cooperation with Wauseon, Delta, Evergreen and Pettisville schools. This ensures no child will go without the necessities throughout the year.  
Funding is also provided to St. Vincent de Paul, Community Pregnancy Center and Fulton County Christmas Cheer.
- ❖ The K. of C. "Support our Seminarians" project will continue through February. Donations at the breakfast held January 12<sup>th</sup> amounted to almost \$800. Donations can continue to be made by using the blue envelopes found at the back of church and placing them in the weekly Mass collection. Last year the program raised \$2,200.
- ❖ Still have a baby bottle? We'll take it!  
Donations to the Pregnancy Center so far is \$1,900.
- ❖ Who are the Knights?  
Founded on the principles of charity, unity and fraternity, the Knights of Columbus was established in 1882 by Father Michael J. McGivney. The intent? To bring financial aid and assistance to the sick, disabled and needy members and their families. St. Caspar Council #8829 began 40 years ago and has about 100 members. Our works support those in need, provides and supports activities for the youth, ministers to the home bound, provide funding for St. Caspar Parish for needs of the building and the congregation, and places a high priority on supporting the pro-life movement and the developmentally disabled.
